On October 5th, 2018, Alicen and I, along with sixteen others, left Rochester, NY, on a mission trip to Zambia. Little did we know that five years later we would begin deputation, and seven years later we'd find ourselves back where it all started, here in Chipata, Zambia, this time with our three children.

This month, while we've continued moving forward in different areas of ministry, much of our time has been spent moving and settling into our new home. There's still plenty to do, but we're beginning to get established, and Lord willing, this will open the door for us to expand our outreach and ministry efforts even more in the months ahead.

We were encouraged this month to see someone trust Christ as their Savior and to watch a few young men finish their discipleship lessons. We also had another youth meeting, which was a great time of fellowship and spiritual growth for our teens. About 60% of Zambia's population is 21 years old and younger, and one of our goals is to make a lasting impact on these hearts that are tender and open to the Gospel.

Of course, every month has its share of challenges. After a long day working on the new house, we were pulling into our temporary home and accidentally ran over one of our puppies. He suffered a fractured femur, but we're grateful for those who prayed for him—his leg is healing well, and Lord willing, he'll gain full use of his leg.

Looking ahead, November is shaping up to be a full month. We'll be hosting the final Village Bible School of the year, holding our first Missions Emphasis Sunday in the city church, and launching our new Village Market Outreaches. Please pray that our people will develop a deeper heart for reaching others, that everything will run smoothly, and for safety as a guest missionary friend joins us from Zimbabwe to help with the Bible school.
