Wings BPS has shipped over 22 million Scriptures in 16 languages to 26 nations so far this year. One highlight of this fall was our *Truth 4 Taubaté* trip to Brazil where we were able to distribute 30,000 Scriptures, see 15 first time visitors receive Bibles, and 6 professions of faith!
